



**Common Teaching Unit plan

Theme of the lesson	Flood prevention
Pupils' age range	15 - 16
Timeline	1 hour
Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will get to know the kinds of floods. 2. Students will define the causes of floods. 3. Students will describe the effects of floods and the ways of preventing floods based on the Millennium Flood from 1998. 4. Students will use apps to search for some information.
Methods	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The teacher presents the objectives to students. 2. Students divide into 4-people teams. 3. The teacher displays the instructions of how to install the Action Bounds app and describes the login process. 4. The teacher explains how the app works and how to play using it. 5. Students collect information from different places at school using the clues prepared in the app. 6. Students write or choose the answers in the app and do the tasks. <p>- Mode: Multiple choice</p> 

	<p>- Mode: Solution input</p>  <p>- Type of solution(text)</p> <p>- Watching a film and searching for answers to the questions. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kPsQYq3IbqA</p> <p>- Challenge: simulation of a flood (building a dam from backpacks)</p> <p>7. When the teams come back, the teacher discusses the answers and displays the results of the teams.</p>

<p>Assessment</p>	<p>Group talk</p>
