<b>methods</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The student installs SSF Storia in their Android or iOS device</li> <li>2) He/sh chooses the historical period that he wants to study (in this case the Middle Ages) and clicks on the specific topic</li> <li>3) To make a good general review of the chapters of history he/she clicks on "Tabs" in the initial screen of the app</li> <li>4) To fix a topic well in your mind, then, it is useful to test yourself through the quizzes included in the app.</li> </ol>
