The students, divided into small groups, will look for information using the Internet.</li> </ol> <p><b>Part II</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Each group will present its work to the class.</li> <li>2. The teacher will help students to reflect upon connexion between French and Italian festivities habits.</li> <li>3. Finally, the students will make a virtual presentation of French Christmas meal.</li> </ol>
